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Statement of Principles

Boarding at LVS Hassocks is based on the following principles:

- the development of the whole person, physically, spiritually, intellectually, morally, socially and emotionally in an atmosphere of positive encouragement;
- mutual respect and the right to be treated as an individual;
- the right of the individual to not suffer any form of abuse;
- an equality of opportunities;
- the right to privacy;
- supportive links with parents and carers.

In addition to addressing physical needs and a sense of security and safety, each house seeks to contribute to its student's development in their sense of belonging, their self-esteem and self-respect and self-realisation.

Aims and Objectives

The aims and objectives of each of the boarding houses will differ in practice depending on age and level of need of our young people, but it will seek to:

- Create a safe, secure and comfortable environment for all young people;
- Provide a small unique setting with a qualified, experienced team who are dedicated to understanding and meeting the complex needs of each young person;
- Provide a range of experiences, opportunities, and conditions that will encourage self-development: physically, spiritually, emotional, morally, socially and intellectually;
- Create an environment where any form of bullying would have difficulty flourishing;
- Develop a sense of responsibility for themselves, the environment and those around them;
- Encourage supportive links and communication between staff, young people and parents;
- Provide a full and rich 24 hour curriculum that supports school learning and encourages personal development;
- Provide opportunities for young people to participate in the wider community;
- Prepare young people for the next phase of life and transition;

We aim for the young people at LVS Hassocks to be:

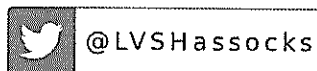
- Safe and happy;

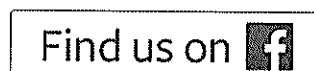
